BOOK REVIEW:

The purpose of this column will be to make you aware of various new books and publications available from various publishers, gleaned from recent genealogical periodicals, book lists from publishers, etc. Also included from time to time will be books recently added to our own Genealogical Library as well as new books of interest at the Kitsap Regional Library.

Recent Publications:

Polyanthos, 811 Orleans St., New Orleans, LA 70116:

Missouri Land Claims, 450 pp, Indexed, \$17.50. This is a reprint of a report of the General Land Office published in 1835. It contains 1000 names and could be quite helpful for those interested in Upper Mississippi Valley history and genealogy.

The New York Magazine: Marriages and Deaths, 1790-1797, 250 pp, Indexed, \$15.00. This book, compiled and edited by Kenneth Scott and Kristin Gibbons, contains funeral and marriage notices from not only New York State, but also all the United States, Canada, the West Indies, and Americans who died abroad. There are approximately 6,000 names, often with ages, places, professions and, in the case of marriages, the name of the bride's father.

Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc., 521-523 St. Paul Place, Baltimore, MD 21202:

Wills and Administrations of Isle of Wight County, Virginia 1647-1800, 375 pp, Indexed, \$17.50. This work was originally compiled and published in 1938 by Blanch Chapman, but has recently been revised and reprinted. It is arranged chronologically and contains over 5,000 wills and administrations.

Maryland Marriages 1634-1777, compiled by Robert Barnes, 245 pp, Indexed, \$12.50. A compilation of marriages from parish records, marriage licenses and printed sources. The book lists names of bride and groom, date of marriage and source of original record. Approximately 24,000 people are referred to.

Other:

Soldiers of the American Revolution Buried in Illinois, 300 pp., \$8.50. Lists all known information on 1,053 soldiers. Available from Illinois State Genealogical Society, P. O. Box '76, Normal, Illinois 61761.

The Canadian Genealogical Handbook, \$12.50. A compilation covering genealogical records in Canada. Available from Wheatfield Press, Box 205, St. James Postal Station, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada R3J 3R4.

On February 21, 1886 the Rev. N.J. Nilsen (first evangelical minister of this area) organized a congregation and in 1887 Jorgen Eliason donated the building site and cemetery grounds for the Fordefjord Church. There was a division of the Lutheran Church in 1897; some members stayed with the Fordefjord Church, the remainder organized as the Free Lutheran Church. Then in 1899 the church became the First Lutheran Church. The original cemetery plots, each containing 6 graves, usually were sold to a head of a family. If all six graves were not used, the remainder were sold back to the church.
