EARLY STATE RECORDS. It is important to remember that certain state records, such as censuses, are sometimes found under a different state. For example:

The 1850 and 1860 Arizona census is included in the New Mexico census for those years.

The 1860 Montana Federal Census is to be found in the Nebraska census under the heading "unorganized territory." Northeastern Colorado is included in this census also.

The 1860 Arkansas Federal Census contains an entry following Yell County, "and Indian lands." This section lists non-Indians living near the various Indian tribes in what is now Oklahoma. The information is included on Reel 52 of Microfilm 653. The 1870 census for this area is missing.

For the 1840 Minnesota census, see the Federal Census of Clayton County, Iowa. "The enumerator included present-day Minnesota in his enumeration of Clayton County"!

From 1650 to 1819, the state of Maine was under the jurisdiction of Massachusetts.

GERMANY. The Gen. Soc. of Utah has microfilmed 671 reels of passes issued to Germans during the Nazi regime. These passes, called Ahnenpass, listed three to six generations of ancestry. (Eastern WA Gen. Soc.)

The United States registered German aliens during World War I. A form for requesting information can be obtained from Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service, Washington DC 20536. Furnish specific name and explain that it is for genealogical purposes.

The Consulate General of Germany, 104 S. Michigan Ave., Chicago IL 60603 will send a free list of genealogical associations in the Federal Republic of Germany. This is East Germany, but please avoid using this term when writing. (Eastern WA Gen. Soc.)

POLAND. The Polish Gen. Soc. has established an Ancestor Index Card File to be housed at the Polish Museum of America. Members and non-members are invited to submit information on ancestors. Write the Polish Gen. Soc., 984 N. Milwaukee Ave., Chicago IL 60622.

SWEDEN. For Swedish research in Minnesota and western Wisconsin, the records of almost all Swedish-American churches have been microfilmed. Write American-Swedish Institute, South Park Ave., Minneapolis MN (no zip code available). Also, a clearing house of information on Swedish family history sources is being established. RELATIONSHIP TERMS USED IN OLD RECORDS. Donald Lines Jacobus, eminent genealogist, is quoted in the National Gen. Soc. Newsletter:

Brother. This term could indicate (1) the husband of one's sister; (2) brother of one's wife; (3) the husband of one's sister-in-law; (4) a half-brother; (5) a stepbrother. Sometimes the term applied to another member of a particular church.

In-laws. In early America records, father- or mother-in-law could have referred to a stepparent. The same applied to daughter- or son-in-law.

Senior, Junior. Prior to the 19th century these terms could have applied to an uncle and nephew, or cousins having the same name.

Cousin. In early New England this term was sometimes applied to a nephew or niece.

"Natural" son. Do not jump to the conclusion this term implies illegitimacy. It indicates a relationship by blood as distinguished from a relationship by marriage. Illegitimate children were usually referred to as "base born."

"Now" wife. When used in a will, some assume this means the testator had a former wife and is referring to the present wife. Not always. When the term is used without reference to children, it usually means the bequest is intended only for the present wife and should not go to any subsequent wife he may have in the future. Where children were concerned, the bequests refer to children by a first wife, and children by the "present" or "now" wife.

Alias. The use of two surnames, joined by the word "alias," usually indicates an illegitimate birth in early American records. The surname of the father and mother are joined by the term. There were other reasons for using this term: sometimes when children inherited through their mother, they used both parents' names; sometimes the name of a natural father was joined to that of a stepfather. The term was also applied in cases of adoption.

In conclusion, Jacobus warns, do not build too much on mention of relationship in early records.

PENNSYLVANIA. Much of the land in northwest PA was once held by Dutch land brokers called the Holland Land Co. Their records have been microfilmed and are now in possession of the Fredonia New York State University.

Queries are free in "Our Keystone Families," a genealogy column published in several central and eastern PA newspapers. Write Schuyler C. Brossman, Box 43, Rehrersburg PA 19550.

TENNESSEE. The Tennessee State Library and Archives, 403 7th Ave., Nashville TN 27219 will make a free search of microfilmed county records. Send SASE for correct form to use.

TEXAS. If you are descended from early day Texans, get the pamphlet, "Guide to Genealogy" from the Records Division, General Land Office, Austin TX 78701. This office has records of original land grants issued by Spain, Mexico and the Republic of Texas.

SOUTH CAROLINA. The Andrea Collection, a source for southern research especially South Carolina, has been microfilmed. A surname index is easily checked. Order films at LDS branch libraries.

NEWS FROM MICHIGAN. A massive microfilming project of state newspapers has been completed. Over 1,110 newspapers from 292 cities and towns of Michigan going back to the 1840's are included. Available on interlibrary loan, the project contains over 60,000 reels. Write to the Library of Michigan, PO Box 30007, Lansing MI 48909.

The bad news from Michigan is that many Michigan counties now have closed their naturalization records because they were considered to be under the Privacy Law. The NW Washington newsletter warns, if you need naturalization records, don't delay! All states may soon follow suit!

MISSOURI NEWSPAPERS. Information as to what newspapers were published in your area of interest may be obtained from the Newspaper Library of the State Historical Society of Missouri, 1020 Lowry St., Columbia MO 63102. They need to know the county, town and dates. Microfilms available on interlibrary loan. Included SASE.

BEATRICE BAYLEY ET AL. This person, who was recently put out of business by the post office, has been succeeded by two more "mail order" genealogists. They are Elizabeth Ross of Scranton PA and Mary Whitney of Ottsville PA. They offer the same type of information: namely, a list of everyone in the country who bears one particular surname. The Olympia quarterly says that many genealogists claim this is usable information, but everyone should know what they are getting for their money.

BURNED COURTHOUSES AGAIN. One man in Tacoma, frustrated by a burned courthouse in Pulaski Co. Missouri, started a newspaper column in that area specializing in queries relating to the area. He has accumulated a body of information covering a thousand different early Missouri surnames. The area includes ten counties. He is Don Vincent, 936 N. Skyline Drive, Tacoma 98406. The newspaper carrying his column is The Richland Mirror in Richland MO.

PHOTO ALBUMS. An article in the Tacoma quarterly warns against the inexpensive magnetic type photo albums sold these days. The article says the albums often have transparent coverings of polyvinyl chloride (PVC) and an adhesive which reacts on photographic chemicals. Even the old black page albums are made of highly acidic papers. Camera shops and archival supply houses are the best places to obtain albums not injurious to pictures and clippings. (See The Researcher, Tacoma-Pierce genealogical society quarterly for Winter 1986 for more information, page 67.)

HAMBURG, GERMANY RECORDS. If your ancestor went through the port of Hamburg between 1850 and 1914, the Hamburg Historic Emigration Office can furnish a wealth of information. Nearly five million people who left Germany, Poland, Russia and other eastern European countries are included in the microfilm files. Supply the emigre's name and year of emigration when inquiring. The search costs \$30 but you will obtain the person's age, occupation, marital status, number of children, city of origin and ship's name, destination, date of sailing. Write Historic Emigration Office, Holstenwall 24, 2000 Hamburg 36, West Germany.

CARLOW AND SURROUNDING COUNTIES. The Irish in County Carlow are now compiling genealogical data for Carlow and surrounding counties. Their goal is a permanent computerized genealogical service in the area. Write Michael Purcell, County Carlow Heritage Society, 4 Kennedy St., Carlow, Ireland.

HELPFUL HINT. A yellow sheet of paper placed on the reading surface of some microfilm readers may be of some help in making difficult film easier to read. (Clark Co. Trailbreakers)
