The quarterly bulletin "Family Backtracking" began publishing in February 1976. Volume 1, Number 1 lists the name of the club as the Olympic Genealogical Society. Programs for that year began with Arthur Fiske who was coming over from Seattle to talk on "Problem Solving." Other meeting would be devoted to a trip to the Seattle Public Library, a talk on Church Records by Jackie Smalley, and a class in beginning genealogy taught by Marlys Marrs. Donna Jean Bruce was president that year. The bulletin published a map to Marlys Marrs' house and dues were \$5 per person or \$7 per family. Roseann Mitchell was editor of the bulletin.

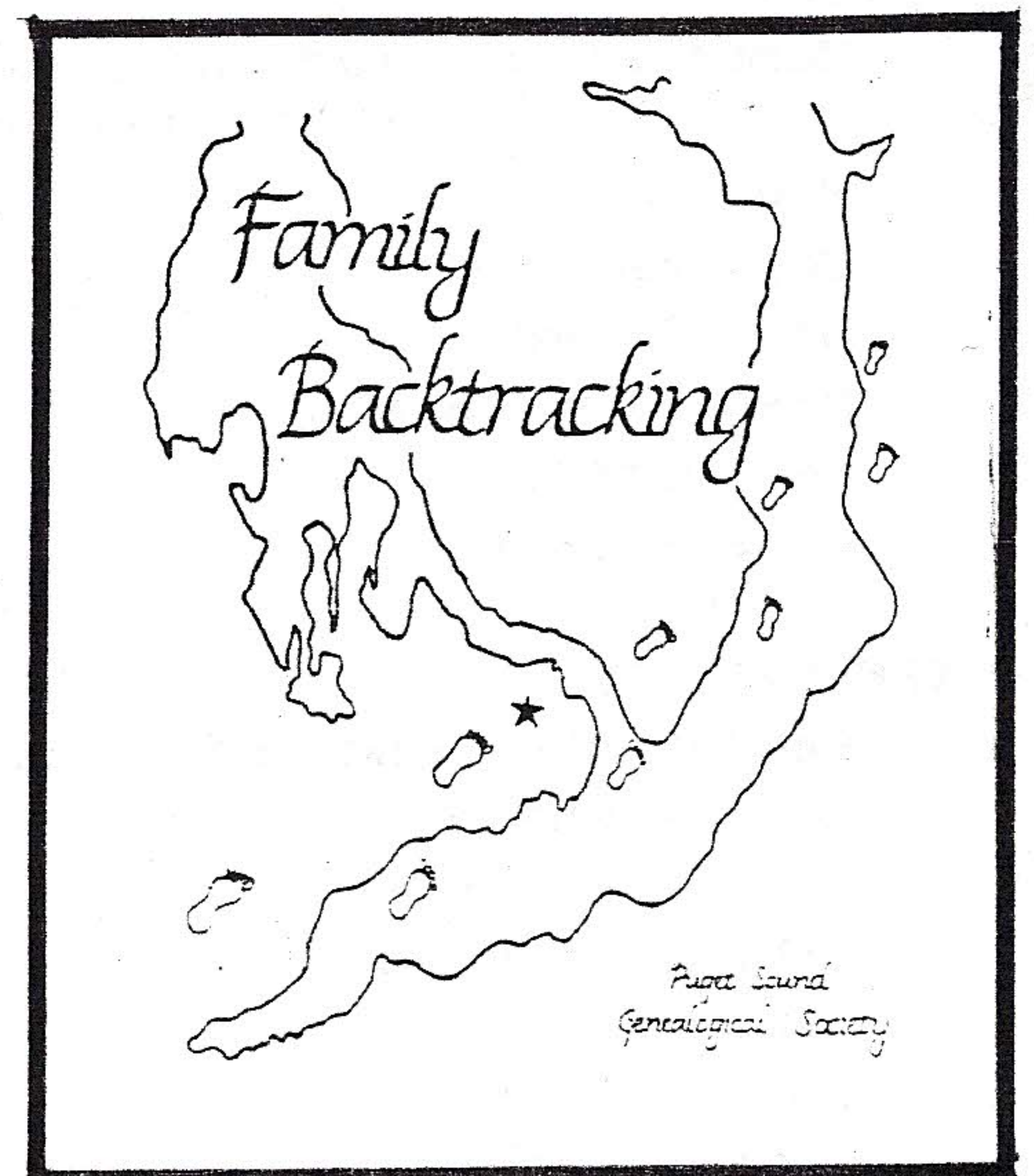
In Volume 2 (1977) "DJ" Bruce was still president; the name of the club had been changed to Puget Sound Genealogical Society, and the Evertons were coming to present a seminar.

Volume 3 (1978) saw Sharon Streitt as president and Ruth Manning took over editorship of Family Backtracking.

In 1979 the club joined the Federation of Genealogical Societies and Sharon Streitt was president.

In 1980 the North Kitsap Chapter was formed. President of this group was "DJ" Bruce, Diane Anderson was Secy-Treasurer and Betty Clark was chapter representative to the main club. Marlys Marrs was president of PSGS that year.

In 1981 the "Belfairies" flew in from Belfair and the club has never been the same. The Belfair Chapter has been a vital and hard-working

group through the years. Jackie Horton was president in 1981 and again in 1982. In 1983 and 1948 Rose Mary O'Brien took over and in August of 1984 Mary Penland became editor of Family Backtracking.

Succeeding presidents have been: 1985, Mark Hester; 1986 "DJ" Bruce; 1987, Sharon Streitt. Sharon resigned because of job commitments and Carol Neumann finished her term. Marlys Marrs served again in 1989, succeeded by Dick Helander, who held the office for 1990 and again in 1991.

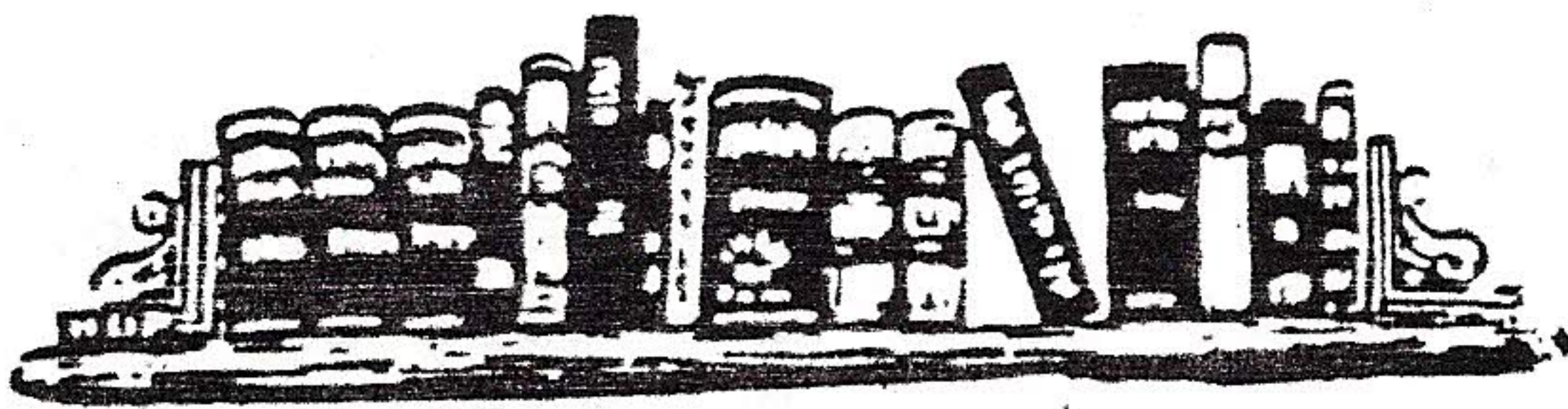

# Library Acquisitions

PHOTOGRAPHING YOUR HERITAGE, by Wilma Sadler Hull (soft bound, \$7.95 plus \$2.50 S&H, 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", 128 pages, illustrations, index, 1988. Available: ANCESTRY INC., Dept. SRV, PO Box 538 Salt Lake City UT 84110. ISBN: 0-916489-31-0)

The author explains graphically why the camera can do a job that the photocopier can't. Her main aim is to suggest ways for the genealogist to use a camera more efficiently, improve the quality of genealogical photographs and make family history more interesting and complete.

Many tangible things can be photographed for posterity: ancestors' tombstones and the old homestead. Besides telling how to improve old yellowed and faded pictures, Ms Shull also explains how tintypes whose images are almost gone can be salvaged.

Even advanced genealogists will find the volume far ranging and surprisingly useful. Read it, and supplement it with specific Kodak How-To books, as the author suggests.--E. Douglas Lince.

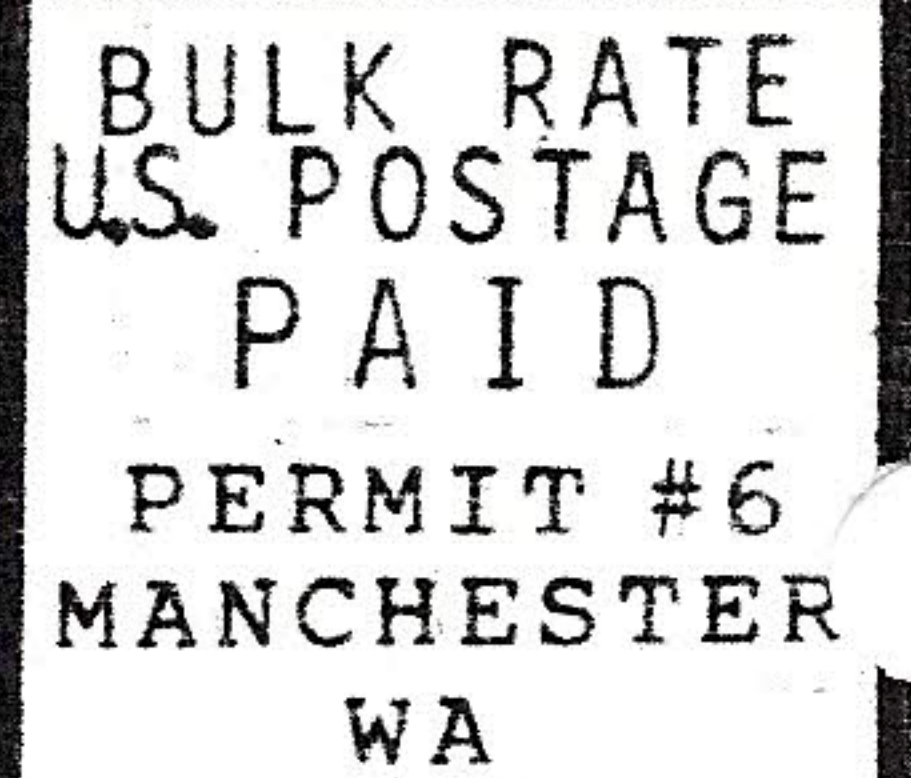

OLD TERMS OF ADDRESS. Customs and styles of clothing aren't the only things that have changed over the last 200 years. Old legal documents and other materials use phrases unfamiliar to modern eyes and ears.

"Junior" or "Senior" did not always refer to father and son. Due to the fact that families were large and middle names very rare, the terms could apply to an uncle and his nephew and sometimes to cousins, each having the same first name.

"Brother" and "Sister" was sometimes used by members of the same religious sect when referring to each other. In old Wills "My sister Smith" could be the testator's own sister; "My brother Smith" could refer to her husband, or some other relationship in the family.

"Goodman, Goodwife (Goodie)" were formal terms for citizens whose worldly goods were less than 200 pounds who had no voice in public affairs. In the 1600's most of the population fell in this category.

"Squire" designated landed gentry or the proprietor class; often applied to the principal landowner in the district (still used in England.)

"Esquire" was a courtesy title for justices of the peace, lawyers or judges.

"Gentleman" was a rank below Squire and was conferred upon a man whose livelihood was derived from income received from the rental of lands.

"Cousin" could be a niece or nephew, a distant relative, especially one outside the immediate family circle. Often used for persons not blood relatives.

"In-law" such as mother-in-law could refer to the second wife of one's father. A stepparent was also called "father-in-law" or "mother-in-law."

"Mr." and "Mrs." were reserved for persons of official position, ministers and the landed gentry. A "Freeman" in Colonial times owned property worth at least 200 pounds, and was a member of the church which entitled him to vote and to wear better clothes.
