CORRECTION! Dick Helander has discovered a bit of misinformation in Ancestry Inc.'s Red Book. Under Vital Records the book says for all pre-1907 Washington State birth and death records write Washington State Archives in Olympia where microfilm copies are available. Records will be searched for \$15 per hour or \$5 per minute.

On calling the Washington State Archives, Dick discovered that Pierce County, the county he was interested in, has never sent their records to Olympia. The county records are not available for personal searches, but Pierce County will conduct a search of their vital records for \$8 for each surname. If a certified copy is wanted add \$3 extra. Address is Pierce County Vital Records, 3701 Pacific Ave., Tacoma WA 98408. A recording at 1-591-6414 will give information, or if you want to "talk to a human," as Dick says, call 1-591-6418.

FUNERAL HOMES. Most morticians have a copy of "The Yellow Book" which lists all the funeral homes in the U.S. and Canada. The book gives cost of death certificates in each location, names of local hospitals, and names of newspapers in each area. The book is published by Nomis Publications, PO Box 5122, Youngstown OH 44512, and the telephone number is 1-800-321-7479. Heritage Quest asks that you mention them in your requests.

USE OF TITLES. "Junior" and "Senior" did not always refer to father and son in old records. The terms could be used to distinguish between two unrelated men of the same name. SWEDISH RESEARCH. Margaretha Hedblom, a genealogist from Dalarna, Sweden, spoke to the Tacoma-Pierce society recently. She presented a video which was one of several she has made for audiences in Sweden, illustrating the Swedish "experience" in the United States since emigration began in the 19th century. She has traveled this country, talking to persons of Swedish descent, gathering letters, pictures, and anecdotes passed down through the generations.

Before 1720 emigration from Sweden was forbidden. However, after Mormon missionaries came in the middle 1800's, Swedish immigration to the United States increased markedly. Crop failures in 1867, -68 and -69 stepped up the tide of Swedes leaving their homeland. She pointed out that those who left were mostly of the middle class, as the poorest could not afford to emigrate. Advertisements of free land in this country appearing in Swedish newspapers lured land-hungry Swedes also.

Passenger agents like the Larsson Brothers provided space on ships as well as railroad tickets to wherever the family wished to go, usually where there was a job waiting. In 1880 she said there were more Swedes in Chicago than in Sweden's third largest city.

When letters arrived in Sweden describing life in the United States many more decided to go. After 1900 more city people immigrated than rural folk. Around 1900 the Swedish government lenghtened the time for army service causing many young unmarried men to leave. Ms Hedblom pointed out that those Swedes immigrating in the 19th century were more apt to keep their language and customs than later ones.

Ms Hedblom's address in Sweden is Norsgatan 30, S-79300 Leksand, Sweden. She is an expert on emigration from Dalarna, and advises people who have genealogy questions on other parts of Sweden to write to The Swedish Emigrant Institute, Box 201, 35104 Vaxjo, Sweden. Remember to enclose International Reply Coupons.

PASSPORTS. If anyone returned to the "old country" on a visit or to stay, they of course needed a passport. Passport applications through 1905 are in the Diplomatic Records Branch of the National Archives, Room 5-E, Washington DC 20408. Passports later than 1906 are in the custody of the Passport Office, Dept. of State, 1425 "K" Street, Washington DC 20502. (Enid OK)

CIVIL WAR RECORDS. A Master Index to Civil War records is available at Allen County Library in Fort Wayne IN. Regiment and company numbers are available in case you wish to order pension records from the National Archives in Washington DC. The Archives has a form for this information which they will send on request. If you are not sure your ancestor served in the Civil War, check the 1890 Special Census which lists all war veterans (providing they were still alive). (Kanawha WV)

REFERENCE MATERIALS IN PUBLIC LIBRARIES. According to Michael Potts, reference librarian at the Shelton Public Library, most libraries have the following helpful materials at the reference desk:

Vital Records Handbook. Gives forms for obtaining birth, death, and marriage information, costs and locations where wanted information is available.

Columbia Lippincott Gazeteer. Lists places that existed formerly, but are no longer on maps.

County Courthouse Books. Give addresses for obtaining records, prices, regulations etc.

Brighams Newspapers (locations of old newspapers and where to write for information). Newspapers in Microform (papers from 1848-1970). Gale Directory of Publications and Broadcast Media (lists all newspapers in the country).

GERMAN NAMING PATTERNS. Germans followed this routine: First son after the paternal grandfather; second son after maternal grandfather; third son after the father. First daughter after maternal grandmother; second daughter after paternal grandmother, third daughter after the mother. (Grant Co. WA)

CANADIAN BOOK REPRINTED. A new edition of "Red Serge Wives," which was out of print for several years, has been issued. The book gives experiences and data on the wives of North West Mounted Police who began following their husbands to western Canada in 1873. Many names are mentioned, and the book includes a reference table of regimental numbers. (Kalispell MT)

STATE CHURCH. Until 1786 all children born in Virginia, regardless of religious affiliation, were required to be baptized in the Episcopal Church, which was the state church. Parish registers giving names, date of birth and names of parents are in the VA State Library, Richmond. (Kanawha WV)

CENSUS RECORDS. Where would genealogists be without them? But remember when using the censuses:

Don't bank too much on census indexes. Mistakes are fairly common.

Don't assume the way names are spelled in the census is the correct way. There are many ways of spelling one name, and some census enumerators were very imaginative.

Don't assume the relationship to the head of the household is accurate. Households, especially in early days, contained many persons who were not necessarily family members.

Don't assume the wife is the mother of any, or all, of the children listed.

Don't assume the ages given provide the birth year--or are even correct.

Copy all information at the top of the page, as well as the data to the right of the occupation column.

Copy all entries for your surname in the county. Check neighbors carefully, too, as they often were relatives.

Don't stop with the Soundex cards. Go back to the original record for all the other information.

Don't forget the 1890 veterans census. Widows are listed here too.

Don't slight records prior to 1850. They give only one name, but can give a clue as to the number of family members you are looking for.

Don't forget that with the 1880 census birth dates for the fathers and mothers were given.

Remember that some states have state census records. These were taken on "off" years and often give valuable agricultural information etc. that can help identify probates and land records. (Garfield Co. Enid OK)
