BITS & PIECES, by Jackie

I recently added new dimension to my research efforts with the installation of a modem on my Personal Computer (PC). In the past, my PC has been used as a word processor and data storage, but I now have access to all bulletin board systems (BBS) throughout the world through the FIDO BBS, which is monitored by the National Genealogical Society. The only problem with the BBS's is that your telephone bill could skyrocket if you get carried away (I've seen messages from as far away as Australia.). I have access to FIDO through a local board listed under the name of Ground Zero and the system operator (SYSOP) charges no fees for its use. The software I chose is the TNT package which is an off-line reader that permits me to select my call, then let the machine do the rest, i.e., dials until a connection is made, uploads my messages to the board, downloads all messages that I have not received, disconnects and stores the information so that I can read the messages at my leisure. I am really amazed at the quantity and quality of the information that other board users are willing to share. I can request information from all around the country on such items as library hours, what is available in the library, where cemeteries are located, etc. I receive answers approximately 90% of the time. The BBS usually has 300 to 400 messages a day. It takes me about 10 to 15 minutes to upload and download the messages and about 30 minutes to review them. There are many French-Canadians on this line, which is of special interest to me. One researcher asked each viewer researching French -Canadian lines to send her a message. At last count, there were over 200 messages for her. I hope some of you will join me on the FIDO board.

RESEARCH AIDS

FEES FOR VITAL RECORDS

As of 1 June 1992, fees increased for Georgia birth and death certificates from \$3 to \$10 for the first copy. Additional copies ordered at same time, same person from \$1 to \$5 each. Increases are standard for all counties. (Central Georgia GS)

The State of Connecticut has increased the cost of a birth certificate from \$5.00 to \$15.00 July 1, 1993. (From Bob Ellis, FIDO-NET BBS)

Massachusetts' fees for birth certificates went from \$6.00 to \$11.00. No Xeroxing, either. You must get an official copy. (From Patti Couture, FIDO-NET BBS)

Latest fees for Kentucky birth and death certificates are \$7.00 for births and \$6.00 for death. For vital records 1852-1910, contact Public Records Division, Kentucky Department for Libraries and Archives, 300 Coffee Tree Road, P. O. Box 537, Frankfort, KY 40602. ON THE TERM "ESQUIRE"

In the United States in this day and age, the term "Esquire" indicates that the person is an attorney and recently female attorneys have won the "right" to use Esq. after their names. However, the original meaning of "esquire" was the title given to a young man aspiring, or in training, to become a knight. Later it was given to a person of the gentry as a title of respect. So a man in England several hundred years ago with the title "Esq." after his name probably was reasonably well-to-do and owned a fair amount of land. (From Earl Cook, FIDO-NET BBS)

They will tell you the rate and the cost in dollars. You then send your check, and they will send you a check in the foreign currency. The fee is \$2.00, regardless of the amount of the transaction. PRESERVATION OF FAMILY FOLKLORE (Or, How to Write My Life Story)

By Jean Balter

Have you ever had someone say to you, "Oh, your life is so interesting, you should write about it."? After considerable thought you answer, "Yeah. But I don't know HOW to begin, and I certainly don't know WHERE to begin." After much frustration I finally designed a system that I have called Routes Taken on Life's Highway. It has really helped to "jog" my memory. There are six parts, and I will introduce you to two: THE TEN BASIC INQUIRIES and LIFE'S HIGHWAY OUTLINE

Some supplies are necessary: 3-hole notebook and paper (lined or unlined) I prefer unlined so that I can make sketches or maps. Index pages. Pencil/pen. Tape recorder and blank tapes (Optional). File folders.

Divide the notebook into the major periods of the Outline. File folders so titled can be used. This will be your file for memories and the expended stories written from your "joggers."

Read the following TEN BASIC INQUIRIES, and set these well into you mind. As you read through the Outline these will help "jog" some memories.

TEN BASIC INQUIRIES

When responding to the Outline, remember the Five "W's" of writing: WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, & WHY

- 1. Earliest conscious memories and/or stories told to you
- 2. Relationships with parents, siblings, playmates, employers, employees and other significant persons (Include the emotions)
- 3. Physical appearance: yourself and others
 - a. stature
 - b. hair, eye, skin coloring
 - c. hair and clothing styles
- 4. Nickname(s) and/or other names used
- 5. Physical surroundings
 - a. address and/or location
 - b. buildings: include floor plan and a room-by-room tour
 - c. landscape description: take a "visual" walk
 - d. weather: include seasonal changes

- 6. Daily routines
 - a. home
- c. school
- b. work
- d. other
- 7. Possessions
 - a. toys and playthings
 - b. cars, equipment, tools
- c. jewelry, furniture, personal property
 - d. books, letters, documents
- 8. Pets and other animals
- 9. Special occasions
- 10. Local, state, national and world events Include the affect on you and/or your family, friends, etc.

Now start filling in the LIFE'S HIGHWAY OUTLINE. There is not a law that says that you must begin at the beginning, or follow it in sequence! Write whatever comes to you mind: simple words, simple sentences, short stories. Don't be concerned with

perfect grammar, spelling, etc. Just WRITE. If lots of things begin pouring out, consider using the tape recorder. Whether you write or use the recorder, make a note of the period in the Outline that you are remembering.

It will amaze you what comes to mind while reading the OUTLINE. By the time all the time-periods have been used, your questions: "How do I begin? Where do I begin?" will have been answered. Make copies of the TEN BASIC INQUIRIES and the LIFE'S HIGHWAY OUTLINE and give them to other family members. It will be interesting to compare what you remember and what someone else remembers about the same event, person, etc.

Now that I have sparked your thinking- - Go For It! It really is easier than you think and it is a whole lot of fun!

RESERVE JUMPERS CERTIFICATE OFFER

On the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the opening of the Port Angeles Reserve, the Clallam County Genealogical Society is issuing a Reserve Jumpers Certificate to any descendant of the more than 1600 men and women who opened the town, upon proof of descent.

On July 4, 1890, an orderly crowd of men and women trespassed on the land that had been set aside as a military reserve above Port Angeles harbor in 1863. That area comprised more than two thirds of the present city of Port Angeles. By prior agreement each claimed two lots and began to cut timber, slash the brush, and build a home on one lot and make improvements on the other. In the meantime, the Washington congressman began the slow process of getting a townsite homestead law passed which would legalize their actions. By terms of the legislation which was finally enacted, anyone who settled before July 5, 1893, proved up and paid for the two lots before a public sale starting January 1, 1894, was given possession. 1694 persons qualified. However, the next few years saw a massive depression in Port Angeles and more than half of the settlers gave up their lots and moved away to find a new life where they could earn a better living.

A data bank that includes the name of each of the 1694 persons has been prepared. Descendants of the Reserve Jumpers may send a SASE for an application form and supply proof of descent before December 31, 1994. A certificate will be issued (\$5.00 for the first certificate and \$3.00 for each additional certificate to the same address). The information will be added to
