1900 Census Records Available to Public

According to Jay Soloman (Administrator of the U.S. GSA) restrictions on access to records of the 1900 census have been lifted. The new ruling allows reproduction of entire rolls of census microfilm for public and research institutions as well as circulation of copies through inter-library loan. Cost is \$12 per roll. All correspondence regarding the 1900 census should be addressed to: 1900 Census, National Archives & Records Service, General Services Administration, Washington, DC 20408.

DIFFERENT FROM NOWADAYS by Mark Hester

I suppose that most people have at least one ancestor that was a farmer. In Popular legend it was the blazing six gun that won the West. But in fact, it was three less romantic innovations-the steel plow, barbed wire fencing, and the portable windmill-that made it possible for the pioneers to settle there. And the first farmers were a tough breed capable of making the best use of this readily available equipment; they often had to live off the wilderness for a year or so before they could get the land ready for crops or cattle.

It wasn't until the late 1830's when John Deere developed plows of slick, smooth saw-blade steel, that the prairies could be farmed. With a Deere plow the heavy sod could be turned with one yoke of oxen or a span of horses. By 1857 Deere was selling 10,000 of his plows a year, mostly to prairie farmers.

No sodbuster wanted to see a cattle herd driven through his fields once they had been plowed and planted, but often he was powerless to stop it. Then in 1874 Joseph F. Glidden patented a practical type of barbed wire that was "lighter than air, stronger than whiskey and cheaper than dirt." This enclosure of the land infuriated the cattlemen and led to some vicious battles on the range.

Meanwhile, windmills, turned by the almost ceaseless prairie wind, pumped water from deep wells into troughs and drinking pails, bringing life to thousands of acres of arid land. These sentinels, which came disassembled from the mail-order houses of the day, stood on nearly every farm or ranch in the Great Plains States until the 1930's when they began to give way to electric power.

FINDING YOUR ROOTS, Jeane Eddy Westin; 1977,(929.1028). "Finding Your Roots" is a handbook for Americans of every ethnic descent--European, Mediterranean, Asian, African, Oriental, Indian. On a state-by state basis, the author provides names and addresses of specialty libraries, bookstores, record bureaus and genealogical societies. She tells, country-by-country, where to write to obtain information from genealogical and heraldic societies, libraries, church registries and embassies. The helpful appendices in this work include: State-by-State Family History Help List; Map Sources for Genealogists; Special Immigrant Passenger Lists; Major Ports of Entry for Immigrants. In addition, there are fascinating stories about the origins of names and coats of arms, together with suggestions on how to write and publish your own family's history.
