**IN PREPARATION FOR THE WORKSHOP:**

Google Earth Pro requires a **Google Account**. If you currently have a Google account, remember to bring your password with you to class. If you do not have a current Google account, take the following steps to create one. If you already have a Google Account, go to Download Google Earth Pro step

1. Go to the Google Account creation page  
<https://accounts.google.com/signup/v2/webcreateaccount?flowName=GlifWebSignIn&flowEntry=SignUp>
2. Follow the steps on the screen to set up your account.
3. Use the username and password to sign into Gmail and other **Google** products like YouTube, **Google** Play, **Google** Drive and **Google** Earth Pro.

**To Download Google Earth Pro**

1. Go to *Google Earth* homepage <https://www.google.com/earth/>
2. Scroll down to *Create maps with Advanced Tools*
3. Select *Download Earth Pro on desktop*
4. Click blue box titled *Accept & Download* after reading and agreeing to *Google Earth's Privacy Policy*
5. Save the setup file in either a download or software download folder on your hard drive by selecting *Save*
6. It should appear in the lower left corner of your PC. Select *GoogleEarthProSetup.exe*
7. In the pop-up box labeled "Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?"
8. Select *Yes*
9. Select *Launch Google Earth Pro*
10. For those who downloaded the app before **March 5, 2019**, please download a new version to replace the old one. By following the steps above.

**Bookmark Earthpoint**

1. Go to Earthpoint homepage <http://www.earthpoint.us/>
2. In left hand column, go to *USA Utilities --- Search by Description*
3. Bookmark this page <http://www.earthpoint.us/TownshipsSearchByDescription.aspx>

Recommendation: **NOT INTENDED FOR TABLET**. Google Earth is difficult to manage using a track pad only. Please use a mouse and mousepad connected to your computer.

1. Bookmark <https://www.davidrumsey.com/home>
2. Select brown box labeled *Browse Over 91,000 Collection of Maps and Related Images in LUNA Viewer*
3. This site displays all the maps available in the David Rumsey Collection held at Stanford University and totals 158,000 maps. At the David Rumsey website are a selected subset of 91,000 are available for viewing on the site. Browse at your leisure. Use the left column to refine your search by the facets: what, where, who, when.
4. All are available for personal use and can be downloaded or printed
